

Mississauga South

Completed Works

- New Eaglewood bridge reopened on July 4, 2024
- Inglewood bridge demolished (Week of July 9, 2024)
- All electric work between Park Street and Inglewood has been completed. Handover to utility partner in this area also completed.
- Installation of primary conductors has been completed between Mineola Road and Pinewood

Current Works

- Road widening continues along the west side of Hurontario Street (Expected to be completed by end of July 2024)
- Electrical, plumbing, masonry and other works at Port Credit Station (Summer 2024)
- Hydro pole erections near QEW (Summer 2024)
- Lighting works in the QEW Pushbox (End of July 2024)



- Construction of guideway at Mineola Road intersection (22 July to August 19, 2024 pending city approvals)
- New Alectra connections to adjacent properties (Summer/Fall 2024)
- Removal of old hydroelectric poles (Summer 2024)
- Grading changes to match elevations (Fall 2024)
- Architectural finishes to the Port Credit Station (Fall 2024)
- Platform level plumbing works at Port Credit Station (Scheduled for completion by mid-August)
- Flood walls construction completed at Mary Fix Creek



- Road widening between Bronte College and Dundas
- Track installation at The Queensway (August 2024)
- Telecom manhole works at the southwest corner of Hurontario and Dundas (Scheduled for completion end of July 2024)
- Alectra duct bank works from Hillcrest to John Street (Early-August 2024)
- Installation of Traction Power Substation (TPSS) at Central Parkway (Box to be delivered end of July 2024)
- Track installation between
 Fairview Road and Matthews Gate
- Preparatory works for Fairview Stop (Summer 2024)
- Sanitary and other connections between Dundas and Paisley



- Telecom installation beteem The Queensway and Fairview Road (Fall 2024)
- Telecom manhole works on east of Dundas and Hurontario (Summer 2024)
- Construction of Fairview Road Stop (End of Summer 2024)
- Installation tracks at Hillcrest, King Street, Paisley Boulevard and Bronte College Court (Summer/Fall 2024)



- Track installation at Burnhamthorpe Road from July to September, resulting in temporary lane reductions and turn reductions. Weekend works scheduled from July 27-30 and August TBD
- Telecom infrastructure installation
- Guideway works from Robert Speck to Square One Drive (Summer 2024)
- Robert Speck Parkway Stop construction (Summer 2024)
- Preparatory works for Burnhamthorpe Stop (Summer 2024)
- Switchgear connections from Elia Avenue to Eglinton Avenue (Scheduled for completion by end of July 2024)

Elevated Guideway

- Retaining walls and abutments construction continues for the elevated guideway
- The elevated guideway has now reached halfway over Hwy.403. Piers are being constructed on the north side (Summer/Fall 2024)



- Weekend works for Burnhamthorpe track installation
- Completion of Highway 403 Bridge rehab (end of August 2024)
- TPSS construction completion north of Highway 403(Summer/Fall 2024))
- OCS pole installation between Eglinton and Elia
- Electrical conduit and telecom installations over the elevated guideway (Fall 2024)

- Installation of Traction Power Substations (TPSS) at Britannia, Longside, Matheson, Elia and Eglinton (Spring/Summer 2024)
- Continued utility relocations and upgrades
- Energization of TPSS along the segment (Fall 2024)



- Installation of Overhead Catenary System (OCS) poles (Summer/Fall 2024)
- Embedded track installations throughout the midblock
- Continued track work leading into the Operations, Maintenance and Storage Facility (OMSF)
- Installation of canopies at some stops (Fall/Winter 2024)
- TPSS (Fall/Winter 2024)



- Partial driveway closures for road widening activities (Summer/Fall 2024)
- Installation of irrigation lines
- Hydrant relocations and new installations (Summer 2024)
- Traffic configuration change at the Highway 407 ETR overpass (Summer 2024)
- Widening of the southeast on-ramp to Highway 407 ETR (Summer 2024)



- Continuation of work on new Highway 407 ETR structures
- Installation of stormwater management infrastructure
- Continuation of boulevard runs
- TPSS Construction (Fall/Winter 2024)
